Mark comes to us from Nashville, Tennessee, where he has served as professor of New Testament at David Lipscomb University for the past twenty years. He holds degrees from Freed-Hardeman, Harding, and Princeton universities and has a doctorate in New Testament from Emory University.

Mark is the author of the College Press NIV Commentary on the gospel of Luke, and is co-author of the commentary on 1 and 2 Peter in the same series. Mark has also preached for a number of churches in the Nashville area.

For the past four years he has served as minister for the Woodbine Family Church for children in the inner city. Mark and his wife Margo have three grown daughters. We welcome him to our services and to our pulpit today.
