

After graduation, they'll return to their home countries (Malawi, Sudan, Zimbabwe, Zambia, Eswatini) to spread God's love and call to allegiance, to build a more stable life for their families and communities, to strengthen churches, and to be a bright light for the Gospel of King Jesus! Soon after graduation, the college is launching an all-new Bachelor of Theology program with a new intake of students in May 2024.
